Child care staf are cert fed according to the requirements of the licence by facility type. An early childhood centre requires a Type I licence; a family child care home or school-age child care centre requires a Type II licence.

In Type 1 centres

A centre director requires a one-year ECE cert f cate or equivalent.



No minimum training requirements in legislat on.

Must be at least 19 years of age, have a clear tuberculosis test, proof of vaccination, and a criminal record check that is updated every 5 years. All staf must also hold a first aid certificate, and where available, CPR training.

Support staf may be under the age of 19 and work under the supervision of a primary staf person.

An operator of a centre must be at least 19 years of age and have completed a post-secondary program in child development sat sfactory to the Director of Child Day Care Services or sat sfactorily demonstrate an understanding of developmentally appropriate practices and the ability to apply that understanding in the child care program.
